WINE INTRODUCTION

Château Petit Bois was born from the love story between a man, Robert Vergniol, and the appellation Lussac. In 1947 Robert Vergniol decided to buy lands that nowadays are the identity of Château Petit Bois. With scrupulous care and successive purchases, he turned what was then just some lands and few vines into a splendid estate in the heart of Lussac appellation. Today his son Bernard is in charge of the property and contribute to develop the fame of this wine all around the world.

APPEARANCE, AROMA AND TASTING NOTE

Château Petit Bois 2014 présente un intense rubis couleur avec des nuances violettes. Le nez est puissant et très expressif avec des notes de fruits noirs légèrement boisés. À la bouche, ce vin est charnu et très équilibré avec des tanins soyeux et ronds. La finale est longue et élégante.
