

# COLLE CORVIANO TREBBIANO D'ABRUZZO 2020



## WINE INTRODUCTION

Home to an undiscovered gem of ancient roots, the Central Italian region of the Abruzzi is rich in extensive mountain vegetation and gentle sea breezes from the Adriatic Sea. Almost 3.000 years of constant uninterrupted presence of Man have developed the presence of agricultural and pastoral communities such as those originating on Colle Corviano. The aromas of this easy drinking juicy white are delightful: Citrus, tangerine and stone fruit make up the core. A bright and refreshing white wine ending with a lovely stony minerality. Trebbiano is one of Europe's most popular varieties first narrated by Pliny the Young over 2.000 years ago in Central Italy. This great wine inevitably has a strong sense of place, and is a product of both the natural environment and human culture in which it is born.

## WINEMAKER VINTAGE DESCRIPTION

The cool night climate yielded Trebbiano d'Abruzzo, Pecorino, Pinot Grigio and Chardonnay into beautifully concentrated wines with intense aromatics, optimal texture and structure, and high acidity (healthy levels of malic acid). Head winemaker Paolo Benassi experienced a great vintage for his second harvest in Abruzzo. This vintage has been characterized by perfectly healthy grapes. We have thus obtained wines of great concentration and color, and of splendid acidity. All varieties will have an extraordinary aging potential.

## WINEMAKING NOTE

The presence of Trebbiano in Italy is traced back to over 2.000 years ago: Roman Historian Pliny described a "vinum trebulanum" in present-day Abruzzo. Its etymology indicates a popular white wine produced throughout the countryside. A favorite among Italian vignerons, it is one of the most widely cultivated varieties in the world, producing refreshing and delicate single-varietal wines, French Cognac and traditional balsamic vinegar.

## APPEARANCE, AROMA AND TASTING NOTE

Pale straw with light green hues. Intense bouquet of ripe apple and peaches, with pleasing acid touch and mineral sapidity. Italian porchetta, caprese salad, seafood salad, Seafood pasta or risotto, grilled fish.
