WINE INTRODUCTION

"Caligo", or "mist" in Friulian dialect, evokes the freshness of Sauvignon del Collio, bringing to mind the light morning mist which surrounds the vineyards, a place unique in the world.

WINEMAKING NOTE

The grapes undergo a cold maceration to enhance and bring out the aromatic fraction typical of this grape. Contact with oxygen is avoided during the whole vinification process so as to preserve the wine's bitter- sweet notes.

APPEARANCE, AROMA AND TASTING NOTE

A delicate yellow colour with pale green highlights; very intense aromas with notes of passion fruit, nettle and boxwood; sharp and fresh flavoured with a distinct and lingering mineral finish.
