WINE INTRODUCTION

Friulano is considered the flagship wine of this border country. The name "Furlanà", meaning "speaking Friulian" in the local dialect, was chosen because the variety has been here since forever, loved and grown by Friuli winemakers for so long that it speaks their language.

WINEMAKING NOTE

Once grapes arrive in the winery, they undergo soft pressing and slow fermentation of the first-pressing must starts in temperature-controlled steel tanks. Some of the grapes ferment and settle in oak vats.

APPEARANCE, AROMA AND TASTING NOTE

Intense straw-yellow in colour ; a fragrant aroma of elderflower, tisane, camomile with a typical bitter almond note; a pleasant fresh, vibrant flavour also soft and velvety with a back palate of white peach.
