WINEMAKER VINTAGE DESCRIPTION

These genuine wines tell the story of a family and its love for working the land and growing grapes. The Cescon family has been running the winery for three generations. Since the 60's they have passed on their passion for wine, caring for the vineyards and the indigenous grape varieties that truly represent the territory, from the river Piave to the hills famous for Prosecco. Over the course of the past three generations the Cescons have always believed in nature, honest human labour and a search for quality deeply rooted in tradition. However, they have also invested in the newest technology to become renowned wine makers of quality Prosecco.

WINEMAKING NOTE

This Pinot Nero Rosato comes from a careful selection of Pinot Nero grapes through a rosé vinification; the grapes are subjected to cryomaceration (being in contact with the grapes skin at low temperature), and after a few hours the peels are separated from the must to obtain the classic pale pink color. Made by the Charmat method and the addition of selected yeasts.

APPEARANCE, AROMA AND TASTING NOTE

The nose is fresh and fragrant with hints of flowers and fresh fruits. The palate is balanced and the wine will pair perfectly with first courses, fish dishes and cheeses.
