WINE INTRODUCTION

Nanfrè is the name of a locality in Illasi and also the name of the vineyard. It is the nickname of the previous owner of the vineyard who's name was Gianfranco. This is our young Valpolicella vinified in inox, very fresh and fruity, with a moderate alcohol content.

WINEMAKING NOTE

Destemming at 22-23 degrees. Harvest: by hand in crates. Pressing: soft, with pneumo-press. Fermentation: alcoholic at a controlled temperature with selected yeasts for 8 - 10 days. Malolactic fermentation: natural with alcoholic. Bâtonnage: in stainless steel with special mixers once a week until bottling. Stabilization: cold physical. Aged in steel at a controlled temperature 6 months.

APPEARANCE, AROMA AND TASTING NOTE

Intense bright ruby red in colour. The aromas are fruit-lead, with hints of cherry and red fruit, floral and spicy nuances. The palate is soft and fresh, fragrant and savoury with moderate tannins.
